The Gathering will resume on Wednesday, February 21 at 7:00 p.m. after Evening Prayer. We will be going through a Lenten study together. We'd love to have you join

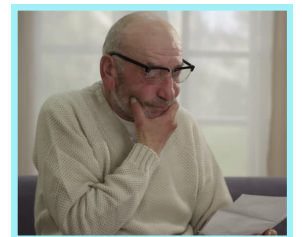
us for this special time of study.

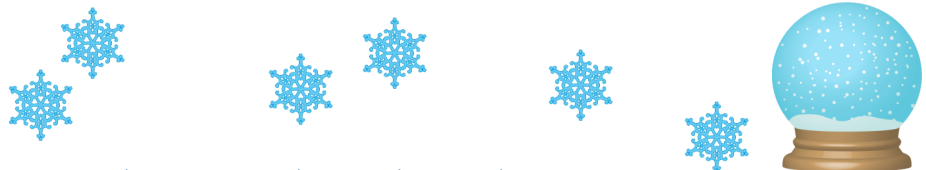
