We will be beginning to gather for worship once again in person on June 7. Please read the details of what this “soft opening” will look like, as detailed in Pastor Bruce’s letter to the congregation.

Here is a shortened summary of those details:

- ◆ The building will be open to gather for worship. Other events or meetings will continue not to use the building.
- ◆ We will meet in Cowan Hall, and All Saints will meet in the sanctuary. This makes it easier for us to sanitize after our time together and have fewer possibilities for cross-contaminating between congregations.
- ◆ We will meet at 9:30 a.m. as usual and ask people not to come too early or stay too late.
- ◆ Please consider wearing your face mask to church in consideration of others.
- ◆ There will be no bulletins or singing, but we will “hear the Word, pray together, and soak in the Spirit of God in the midst of His gathered people.” Ron will be providing special music.
- ◆ The services are being offered for those in good health and who are willing to be out at this time. Please stay home if you are uncertain or if it would compromise your health to come.
- ◆ Pastor Tully will continue to provide the weekly podcasts, which will be available on the Monday after the service. To access these podcasts, go to the website, click the media button, and choose “podcast” from the dropdown menu.
