He will hold me fast. He will hold me fast. For my Savior loves me so, He will hold me fast. He Will Hold Me Fast is another worthy example of a hymn that combines old and new. The original words and hymn tune were written more than a century ago; in 2013 composer Matt Merker added a verse and set the text to a new melody.

The Story Behind the Hymn: while accompanying an evangelistic tour, Australian pianist Robert Harkness (1880-1961) met a new believer who feared he might not be able to "hold out" through the difficult journey of the Christian life. Harkness mentioned his desire to encourage believers of the power of God's sustaining hand to British writer Ada R. Habershon (1861-1918). In 1907 Habershon penned the words for the hymn, When I feel My Faith Will Fail and Harkness composed the tune.

Matt Merker was inspired to write his own version, He Will Hold Me Fast, during a time of doubt and uncertainty. He was struck by the realization that "it's not the strength of our faith that ultimately saves and sustains us; Christ is the One who saves us and sustains us to the end."

Jude 24:20-25 - Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of His glory with great joy.

Philippians 1:6 – And I am sure of this, that He who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

John 10:28-29 – I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand.

His promises shall last: Christ has died, Christ is risen, and Christ will come again.
