And home, rejoicing brought me.

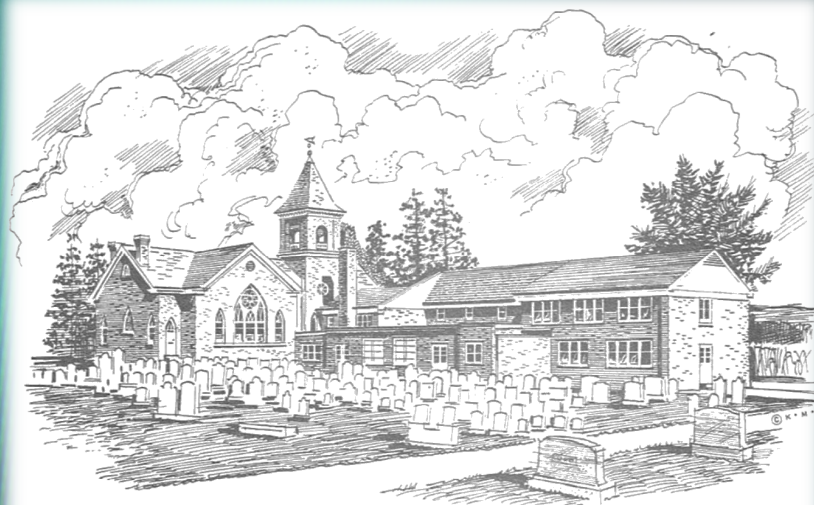
