The Meaning: The four verses of the hymn describe the attributes of God, His sovereign plan and His faithful promises to us.

God is sovereign; in His omnipotence He sustains the world and holds us in His care. His power is unequaled, His promises are true, and He is worthy of our worship and love.

God sent His Son to bear the punishment for our sins; though we were dead in our sins, through His death on the cross we are redeemed -- saved from God's wrath and condemnation and restored to a right relationship with Him.

God foreknew us; He knows the end from the beginning and is working out His plan and purpose in His creation and in our lives. All glory goes to Him. We rely on Him completely, trusting Him beyond our human comprehension, knowing that His promises are true.

Our omniscient God has ordained that Christ will return to reign for eternity. As we bow before Him, we rest securely in His steadfast, loving control.
