Leader: Why is the Son of God called “Jesus,” that is, Savior?

People: Because He saves us from all our sins, and because salvation is not to be sought or found in any other.

Leader: Do those also believe in the only Savior Jesus, who seek their salvation and welfare from “saints,” themselves, or anywhere else?

People: No; although they make their boast of Him, yet in their deeds they deny the only Savior Jesus;1 for either Jesus is not a complete Savior, or they who by true faith receive

this Savior, must have in Him all that is necessary to their salvation.

Leader: Why is He called “Christ,” that is, Anointed?

People: Because He is ordained of God the Father and anointed with the Holy Spirit1 to be our chief Prophet and Teacher, who has fully revealed to us the secret counsel and will of God concerning our redemption; and our only High Priest, who by the one sacrifice of His body, has redeemed us, and ever lives to make intercession for us with the Father; and our eternal King, who governs us by His Word and Spirit, and defends and preserves us in the redemption obtained for us.
